COVID-19 Priority Areas



Collaborations and Mergers – We believe nonprofits will be fighting for an increasingly limited pool of funding in the wake of COVID-19. One option for strengthening community services, reducing overhead and becoming more effective at securing funding is merging with another organization with matching services and values. Scenario Planning – Funding is, and will continue to be, down this year: some predict by as much as 50 percent in 2020.
